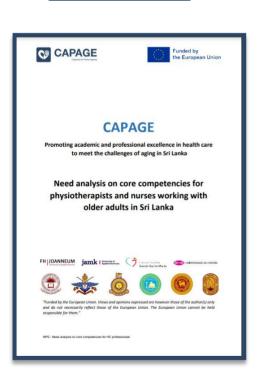

1st Deliverable Submitted

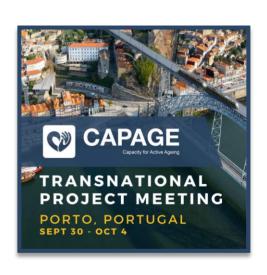
